Council is beginning the process of establishing City of Ryde's first 24/7 library, which is a wonderful initiative that will benefit many different sections of our community.

At the Ordinary Meeting of 22 October 2024, it was resolved that Council will investigate and report on the most suitable location within the City of Ryde to conduct a 12-month trial of the 24/7 library as well as identifying the resourcing and budget required to conduct the trial.

We will also seek feedback from a broad range of community members such as existing library users, students, workers, professionals, local businesses, and families on their needs.

A similar trial by Northern Beaches Council at Forestville Library in early 2023 proved a great success and that library now has a full-time 24/7 completely exceeded expectations.

PARKRUN BEGINS


I am thrilled to report that the new Macquarie Park Parkrun – a free, fun, and friendly 5km community event – is literally up and running.
