Welcome to the Granny Smith Festival, one of Sydney's largest street celebrations, where the community gathers to honour Maria Ann Smith (Granny Smith) and her iconic Granny Smith Apple. It was here in Eastwood 1868 that she 'accidentally' grew the first Granny Smith apples, when some crab apple seeds had sprouted in the compost heap, and she recognised them as a new kind of seedling.


## CARNIVAL FUN AND CAMEL RIDES
