
The City of Ryde wishes you a happy Lunar New Year, celebrating the year of the Snake.

The Lunar New Year, which has been celebrated in many Asian cultures for around 4,000 years, is based on the cycles of the moon. It is also known as Chinese New Year or Spring Festival. There are four elements to the New Year festivities, starting a week out with Little Year, followed by a day of memorial and prayer, then New Year's Eve itself, and concluding with a day of reuniting and gift-giving.

Traditional ways to celebrate the Lunar New Year include putting up decorations, eating dinner with family on New Year's Eve, distributing red envelopes and other gifts, and watching lion and dragon dances.

Year of the Snake

The Year of the Snake has different meanings and connotations depending on culture. In Korea, 2025 is the year of the blue snake, a symbol of patience and immortality. In Chinese culture, the snake is also known as the 'little dragon', and it represents change and opportunity. In Vietnamese culture, the snake is a symbol of duality – intelligent, adaptable, and mysterious, but
